22. Bellevue Street Bridge

23. Chapel Street Bridge Area/Historic Bridle Paths: Bridges played a key role in all of Olmsted's work, not only along rivers, but everywhere that he sought to separate different modes of transportation. The Chapel Street Bridge separated walkers above from the bridle path below.
